Huddersfield made a bright start with openers Jack Cooper and Captain Tom Webster bringing up the first 50 inside 11 overs. Cooper then fell in 12th over for 36 being the first of a number of Huddersfield batsmen to get a start before failing to go on. Webster(17), Nathan Jones (21), Jack Hinchliffe(32). The score was made competitive with enterprising knocks of 29 from Harry Franklin and 21 not out from Siraj Sajid at the end as the innings closed on 188 for 7. Aire Wharfe's reply was struggling from the off when Alex Crane struck in the 3rd over and continued to do so as the Huddersfield bowlers shared the wickets with Crane (2) Tommy Woodhead (2), Siraj Sajid (3) and Nathan Jones (2) all contributing to Aire Wharfe's demise in the 28th over for 94. This sets up a winner takes all game tomorrow with York who beat Wetherby today in the other group game.

York won the toss and didn't hesitate in choosing to bat on a very good batting wicket on this extremely large ground. Huddersfield struck an early blow when Alex Crane removed one of the opening pair in the second over. York then built their innings cautiously with their other opener Loten being especially watchful. They took drinks after 22 overs at 84 for 3. For the next 15 overs with Loten still in the score was accelerated as he took advantage of some Huddersfield lapses. When he fell for 84 in the 38th with the score on 168 a score of 220 plus looked a possibility but Huddersfield recovered some composure and restricted their hosts to 203 for 7. Huddersfield knew this would test their batsmen but on this very good wicket the task was not beyond them. Jack Cooper found his feet in the 7th over helping himself to 12 off their otherwise tidy opening bowler with three well struck fours. Huddersfield progressed nicely and at the end of the 16th over were 59 without loss ahead on runs and wickets in comparison to the York innings. In the next over the first wicket fell with Cooper going for a good 43. Huddersfield were then unable to escape from the grip which the York spinners, bowling in tandem, were able to exert, and didn't help themselves by not finding the gaps in the large outfield and some casual running failed to pressurise the fielders. Alec Jakeman made the top score of 44 but the innings after the fall of the first wicket was always struggling to keep in touch with the required rate. A disappointing way to bow out.
