General feeling was that they were about 50 runs short but still had a chance if they could exert some pressure. A very early wicket was unfortunately followed by a few dropped catches and it was only a couple of wickets taken whilst the scores were level that narrowed the margin of defeat. The Huddersfield team contains some very promising players and they now move to Broad Oak hoping to show Upper Airedale that they can fulfil that promise.
